**SOUTH MILL
DESPATCH**

The ever-growing volume of General Mechanicals produced at Castle Mills brings greater responsibility for South Mill Despatch and our Transport Department. This is the everyday scene as four floors of warehouses discharge shipments of mechanicals destined for all corners of the globe.

When our camera looked down on the scene, Clarke & Co.'s (Smerthwick) vehicle, under the loading platform was taking on Mouldings for the Motor Industry; in the left foreground another Clarke's truck was in position to load Belting and Matting for the Midlands; in the centre, General Merchandise for the North of England via British Road Services (Carmichael's); on right British Road Services (Duncan's) 8-wheeled 14-tonner already loaded with corrugated tubing for London with Draught Tubing baled for Export.
