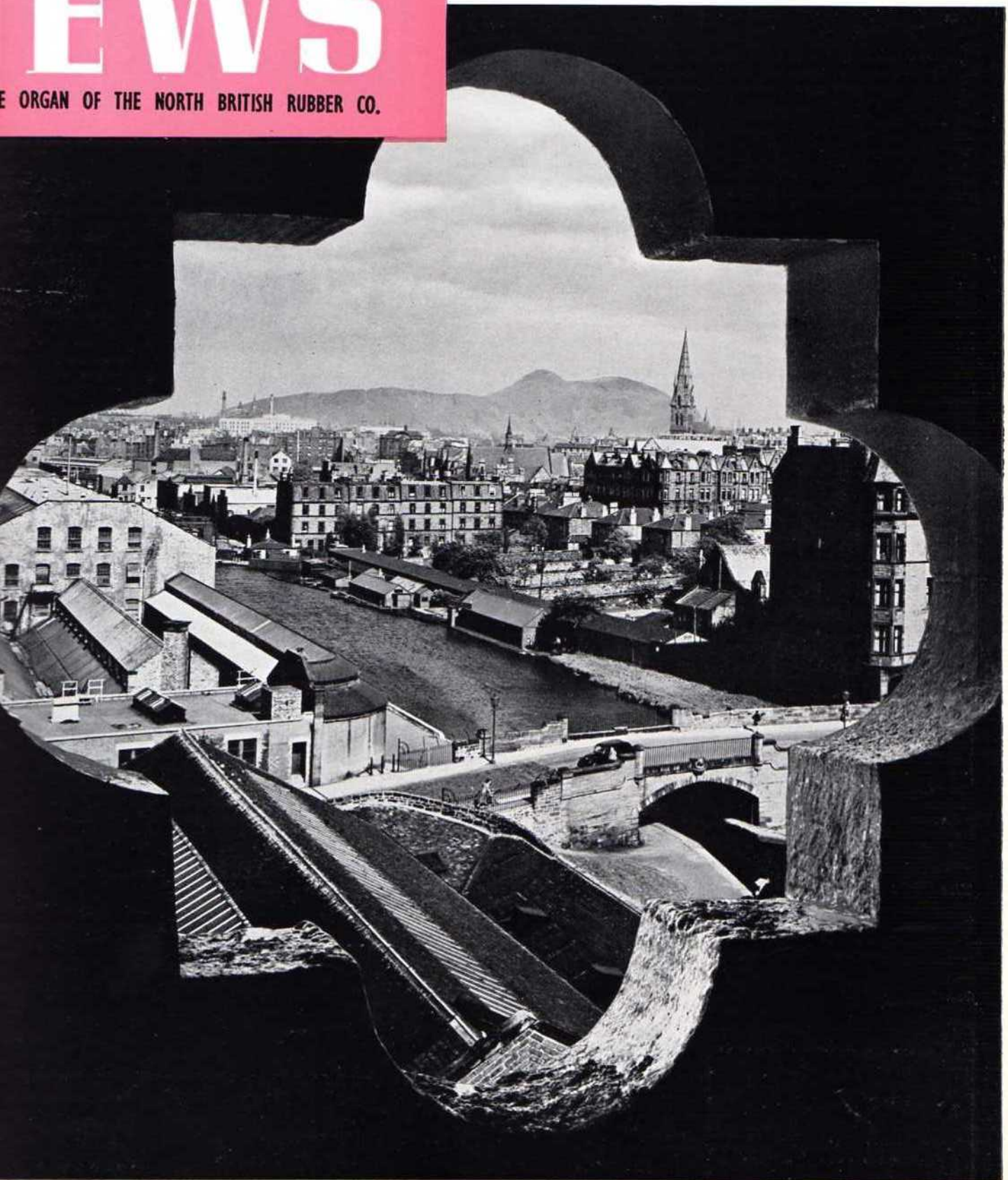

High up in the Vulcanite Block tower there are "windows" in the masonry which command magnificent views of Auld Reekie. It is the home of numberless pigeons, who have been reared in the shadows of Castle Mills. Prominent landmarks of this view looking east are the Royal Simpson Maternity Pavilion, with behind, the dome of the McEwan Hall and spire of the Infirmary. To the right Barclay Church, and all against the background of Salisbury Crags and Arthur's Seat—a magnificent panorama. The Union Canal, linking Edinburgh and Glasgow, is in the foreground.
